## Project update

Elf Farm Supplies began upgrading its Mulgrave facility in late August 2016 to install the latest technology to manage odour generated at the site. The following is a summary of work that has occurred to-date:

- Apex Building Systems in Windsor have commenced work on the construction of the raw materials enclosure. It is expected that the enclosure will be completed by December 2016.
- Earthworks have commenced for the new tunnel building.
- The Biofilter wall footings have been excavated and poured, and the wall construction is underway. Concrete is supplied by Constable Bros in South Windsor.
- The ammonia scrubber footings and slabs have been excavated and poured.
- Approximately 500 new trees have been planted as part of our revegetation works.

We will continue to source local suppliers and contractors throughout this project, where possible.

## Construction Environmental Management Plan

In July, the project Construction Environmental Management Plan was approved. The plan identifies potential construction impacts and sets out the measures in place to ensure that these are minimised or eliminated, where possible. The plan can be viewed in full on the project website.

- Monday-Friday, 7.00am to 6.00pm.
- Saturday, 8.00am to 1.00pm.
- Sunday and public holidays, nil.

## Public information sessions

During August, and prior to the commencement of construction works, Elf Farm Supplies held four public information sessions at the Hawksbury Central Library. Each session ran for three hours. The purpose of these was to give community members the opportunity to learn more about the project, by viewing project plans up close and talking to members of the project team. Public information sessions will continue to be held quarterly until the odour mitigation works are completed.
